## FORESTERS and LOGGERS for ALGER & MARQUETTE COUNTIES

The Forestry Assistance Program of the Alger & Marquette Conservation Districts provides the first professional contact with many landowners who are interested in forest management. Our role is to provide general guidance, basic management planning, and referrals to other public and private resource professionals.

When I encounter a landowner who has a project that could potentially use a consulting forester or logger, I give them our list of consultants and loggers and, with their permission, I send a general description of the project to the individuals on the list via an email message, such as this one.

Anyone interested in pursuing the project described below should respond to me by email within two weeks. You may include additional relevant information in your responses or as attachments. Use good judgment in what you include so I don't have to edit. I will forward your e-mail responses, and/or paper documents, to the landowner. I encourage landowners to contact all of the individuals who reply in a timely fashion, but they may delay or change their mind.

I follow-up with landowners to make sure they get the help they need. Give me a call if you want more information on any of the jobs - I usually have digital photographs and notes.

Forest Type(s) –       Oak/Aspen/Spruce

Work Needed –         Timber Sale Administration and Harvest. Small patches of mature Aspen/Balsam Fir/Spruce for clearing, Red Oak ridges with Red Maple and Birch that need thinning. Approximate volume to be harvested estimated at 300 – 350 cords and 30 MBF Red Oak. Parcel is located on County Road JF/Buffalo Rd., but to access harvest area, a temporary bridge or timber mats must be used to cross a small drainage. A winter harvest is recommended. If interested, I can give you the landowner's phone number for permission to inspect project site.
